



COVID Guidelines

Updated Dec 28, 2021

- All persons entering the building are required to wash or sanitize their hands.
- Face coverings are optional for staff, parents and children.
- Parents are required to sign their child in/out at the front computer.
- Parents will sign their children in and out on the classroom sign in/out sheets.
- Playgrounds will be cleaned/disinfected to the best of our ability.
- Along with our already existing Exclusion Policy requirements, any child displaying the following symptoms will be required to be picked up and stay home for 48 hours and will only be able to return once symptom free.
 - Temperature of 100.4 or higher
 - Excessive coughing (not related to an underlying condition)
- Social distancing will be practiced in the Honu Café to the best of our ability.
- To the best of our ability, we will limit the combining of children.
- If any staff member displays symptoms, he/she will be required to obtain a COVID test and only return once determined negative for infection.
- If a person that a child lives with tests positive for COVID, we would appreciate parents using their best judgement in order to keep their friends, family, classmates, & PCA staff safe. The infected person will not be permitted on premises.
- If a child tests positive for COVID, he/she will be required to self-isolate for five days from the positive result and will only be permitted to return once symptom free. ** In order to hold the spot, 50% tuition will be required during the quarantine time.
- Staff are highly encouraged and have been incentivized to receive the COVID-19 vaccine.

In the event of a positive case:

- Families of the affected classroom will receive email notification.
- The ill person will be immediately isolated and sent home. Per the CDC's guidelines, he/she will be required to self-isolate for a minimum of 5 days, or until symptom free.
- The affected area will be cleaned, sanitized, and disinfected overnight and will reopen the following morning.
- The Brevard County Health Department and the Department of Children & Families will be notified.
- The classroom will remain open and will combine with other classrooms when necessary.
